

DLC Digitisation Masterlist,v3 – Documentation

The DLC Digitisation Masterlist,v3 spreadsheet has tabs (visible from the bottom of the page) for each of the five categories of items:

Journals

Maps

Miscellaneous documents

Letters

Addendum list

The color coding works as follows:

Purple (always column B): these are the LEAP assigned base file names. I've made them purple so they can easily be distinguished once the imaging starts.

Crimson (always column C, but not used on Letters): these are the priority items. As you'll see, the condition information for the Unyanyembe Journal is missing. Once the test imaging phase is complete, we will discuss the order of the priority items with you.

Bright Green rows (only on Letters tab): These are letters that were not assessed due to frames and so have not yet been transported to the University of Glasgow.
