

Level 5, Landing Page and Page Frame – Documentation

Level 5 will allow users to sort and access our core TIFF and XML data by drawing on elements of the MODS data. The functional requirements for this level have been defined in a separate document. Below I walk through the three mockups created for this page.

The display capability in these mockups is, in fact, fully derivative from Levels 2 and 3, so this brief documentation is provided wholly for illustrative purposes.

There are three mockups for Level 5:

1) Level-5-landing.png

This is the landing page for Level 5. This page works in exactly the same way as Level 2 and, in actual fact, is a Level 2 page, so please see the documentation for that page. The user would be taken to this page after clicking on “In His Own Words” from the home page, header, or elsewhere in the site.

There are eight boxes on this page. The first box in the upper left-hand corner (“In His Own Words”) is a static box and will not be hyperlinked or change when a user mouses over it.

The remaining seven boxes reflect the seven browse/search options that will be available on Level 5. Each of these seven boxes will by default display an image (not shown in the mockup). When a user mouses over the image, text will appear instead of that image only. In the mockup, the underlying text for all seven images is given for demonstrative purposes.

The order of the boxes may change and, as with other Level 2 pages, we may ultimately decide on a different layout as per section 5b of the Level 2 documentation: “Note that the combination, placement, size, and number of boxes [on Level 2] is arbitrary and will change from section to section. [...] The point is that we want the level 2 page template configured in order to give us as much flexibility as possible. We will arrange and size these boxes to emphasize particular parts of the site or to capitalize on particular pictures.”

2) Level-5-frame,part1.png

This is the “frame” of the page that will appear after a user digs down into any of the options available from the Level 5 landing page (see above). The elements on display in this mockup function exactly the same as the corresponding elements on Level 3, part 1, so please see the documentation for that part of that level. The white space at the bottom of the image will be filled by the content of the selected browse/search option.

3) Level-5-frame,part2.png

This is the “frame” of the page that will appear after the user scrolls the down the Level 5 page (see previous). The elements on display in this mockup function exactly the same as the corresponding elements on Level 3, part 2, so please see the documentation for that part of that level. The white space at the bottom of the image will be filled by the content of the selected browse/search option.
